






Caribbean Islands



The Antilles



France- over the Atlantic

- Consists of six inhabited islands
- Territory of the EU, France
- Official language French, also Creolen
- Official currency Euro
- Capital - Basse-Terre
- Area 1,628 km² (*Latvia- 39 times bigger*)

Geography

- Washed by the Atlantic Ocean and the Caribbean Sea
- French West Indies, Lesser Antilles
- 2 islands- butterfly shape
- Mountainous island
- Volcano- highest peak 1,467 metres
- Volcanic and earthquake activity in the region




History




- Arawak people- first population of the Caribbean
- C. Columbus- first European in 1493
- *Santa María de Guadalupe*
- Failures to colonize by Spanish
- 1650 sold to French governor, beginning of slavery

- Africa
- French West Indies
- 1685- beginning of huge sugar cane farming
- Boom of Coffee, cocoa plantations- 18th century
- 1946- official overseas department of France





Over 12 million slaves
were transported
from Africa

- Sugar cane- sugar, rhum
- Bananas- 27 kinds
- Squash (pumpkin)- 5 kinds
- Eggplant
- Cocoa
- Jackfruit



Weather patterns

- Coral reefs




